

American College of Radiology Elects Local Physician to Board



Dr. Cassandra Foens recently received the honor of being the first woman and the first radiation oncologist from Iowa to be elected to the American College of Radiology (ACR) Board of Chancellors. Dr. Foens, a native of Waterloo, is a radiation oncologist with Clinical Radiologists, PC. Her office is located at the Covenant Cancer Treatment Center in Waterloo and she has cared for patients with cancer here since July 1994.

Dr. Foens received her medical degree from the University of Iowa College of Medicine in Iowa City. She completed her residency in radiation oncology at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics and in 1992 received her board certification in Radiation Oncology from the American Board of Radiology. Dr. Foens has served as the spokesperson for many cancer related topics in addition to volunteering her time at community screenings and educational presentations. She is the former Cancer Committee Chair and Covenant Medical Center Staff President, and currently serves as Chairman of the Covenant Foundation Board.
